

NT DIABETES IN PREGNANCY CLINICAL REGISTER

INFORMATION FOR WOMEN

All women who have Diabetes in Pregnancy are automatically referred to the Clinical Register; this includes Type 1, Type 2 and Gestational Diabetes.

This register helps Health Professionals know how many women have diabetes during pregnancy. Your Health Professional will explain what the Clinical Register is and how it will be used for improving how we care for women with diabetes in pregnancy.

How long will your information be kept?

Your name and information will stay on the Clinical Register for each pregnancy. You can ask any Health Staff for your name and information to be removed at any time.
